



RULES AND CONDITIONS

All students who participate in **Concours jeune artiste du Manitoba (JAM)** must respect the following criteria:

1. A Manitoba resident aged 13 to 19 years **on March 13, 2010**.
2. Song selection must be entirely in French and appropriate for a family audience.
3. Song length must not exceed four (4) minutes.
4. Participants may perform *a cappella*, or by accompanying themselves with an **acoustic** instrument of their choice (supplied by the participant). An electric piano will be provided.
5. Supply a tape or CD (preferable) recording of the song that the student will be performing. (*Why? This will allow the band to quickly learn the song if the participant progresses to the finals*).
6. Supply tabs and lyrics or the song being performed (if possible).
7. All photos taken of the event may be used for promotional purposes, at the discretion of Canadian Parents for French – Manitoba.
8. Participants must not identify their school or division, at any time or in any way, during their performance. Failure to comply will result in **disqualification**.
