

IMPROMPTU CATEGORY DETAILS

The Impromptu category was developed to encourage senior students who have outgrown their interest in speech competitions. This activity encourages a fresh approach to public speaking. Students require a significant level of mental preparedness and be able to draw from skills acquired by previous years of public speaking. Speech preparation time is limited and topics are pre-selected.

- 1. Impromptu categories are for students in grades 9/10 and 11/12 only. Students in French Immersion, Français and French: Communication and Culture compete in the same category.
- 2. Students can participate in both Impromptu and Speech (Discours) categories.
- 3. Students participating in Impromptu receive their topic on site and have 15 minutes to prepare notes for a 2-4 minute speech. Dictionaries, cue cards, pens and pencils are supplied.
- 4. Students present their speech before a panel of 3 judges.
- 5. No questions are asked to students after their speech.
- 6. Students are judged according to presentation, vocal expression, coherence of speech and quality of language.
- 7. Students are penalized if time allotments are not respected.
- 8. Prizes are awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners.
